Cabaret superstar to grace and mesmerize the crowd at Emperors Palace

Herman van Veen has a philanthropic side which becomes evident in his 51 year tenure as an UNICEF ambassador and humanitarian organisations such as The Columbine Foundation, The Roses for Children Foundation and The Herman Van Veen Foundation.
